

PRIVACY POLICY

This notice describes how the website manages the processing of users' personal data pursuant to Legislative Decree no. 196 of 2003

VERRI collects and uses your personal information in accordance with the provisions of the Personal Data Protection Code (hereinafter the "Privacy Code"), as well as in accordance with Recommendation no. 2/2001 that the European Data Protection Authorities, gathered in the Group established by art. 29 of Directive n. 95/46 / EC, adopted on May 17, 2001 to identify some minimum requirements for the collection of personal data online. The holder of the treatment is VERRI - V40 S.R.L., headquartered in Via Pietro Maroncelli n. 5, 20154 Milan, Italy. The full list of processing officers and third parties Owners of autonomous processing related to those made by VERRI can be easily and free of charge consulted by asking it directly at VERRI.

VERRI may use your personal data - after your express consent - also for commercial and marketing purposes related to the promotion of promotional products or promotions, including third parties such as, but not limited to, the sending of newsletters by email or via sms with promotional or advertising messages. Your personal data will in any case not be transferred by VERRI to third parties. Your consent in this case is optional and the failure to release it will not allow you to receive commercial information from VERRI or participate in the promotional promotions proposed.

Article 7 of the Privacy Code also gives you the option of exercising specific rights, including those to obtain from VERRI the confirmation of the existence or not of personal data concerning you and their making available in an intelligible form; To have knowledge of the origin of the data, as well as of the logic and the purposes upon which the treatment is based; To obtain the cancellation, transformation into anonymous form or the blocking of data processed in violation of law, as well as the updating, rectification or, if there is interest, the integration of the data; To oppose the processing, for legitimate reasons, or to oppose, at all times, the processing aimed at marketing and commercial information. VERRI deals with the personal data of users who access the website www.verri.com and the computer systems and software that operate the site www.verri.com acquire, during their normal operation, some personal data whose transmission is implied in the Use of internet communication protocols.

Such information is not collected to be associated with identified individuals, but by their very nature could, through elaborations or associations, allow to identify the user of the site. This category includes the IP addresses or domain names of computers used by users that connect to www.verri.com, url notation URLs of required resources, the time of the request, the method used to submit the request to Server, the size of file obtained in response, etc. This data is only used to obtain anonymous statistics on the use of www.verri.com site (such as the number of accesses) and to check that it is working properly and they are deleted immediately after processing. This process does not include the processing of directly identifiable information.

COOKIES

VERRI does not use cookies for the transmission of personal information, nor does it use persistent cookies of any kind, i.e. user tracking systems. The use of c.d. Session cookies (which are not permanently stored on your computer and vanish with browser closure) is strictly limited to the transmission of session identifiers (consisting of random numbers generated by the server) needed to allow safe and efficient browsing of the website www.verri.com.

MINORS

VERRI does not collect personal data of minors without the consent of their parents or their legal guardian. For a user under the age of 18 to register at www.verri.com, permission from a parent or legal guardian is required. He / she has to register by leaving his or her personal data and consent to the processing. If VERRI becomes aware that data relating to minors have been communicated without the consent of their parents or legal guardian, such data will be deleted without delay.

Information on the processing of personal data

The information is not valid for other websites that may be consulted through links on the owner's domain websites. The domain's owner is not in any way responsible for third party websites. What is a cookie?

Cookies are short text files that are downloaded on the user's device when you visit a website. At each subsequent visit, cookies are returned to the website that originated them (first party cookies) or to another site that recognizes them (third party cookies). Cookies are useful because they allow a website to recognize the user's device. They have different purposes, such as allowing you to navigate efficiently between pages, remember favorite sites, and generally improve your navigation experience. They also help ensure that online ads are more targeted to a user and his interests. Depending on the function and purpose of use, cookies may be subdivided into technical cookies, profiling cookies, and third-party cookies.

Technical Cookies

Technical cookies are those whose use does not require user consent. These cookies are essential to allow you to browse a website and use all its features. Without these cookies, which are absolutely necessary, a website could not provide any service or function and navigation would not be as easy as it should be. A cookie of this type is also used to store a user's decision on using cookies on the website. This category also includes performance cookies, sometimes called analytics cookies. These are cookies that collect information about the use a user makes of a website and they can improve its functioning. For example, performance cookies show you what pages are most frequently visited, check out what are the recurring patterns for using a website, help you understand every difficulty that users encounter and show the effectiveness of advertising posted on the site. Technical cookies are essential and cannot be disabled using the features of this website. Generally, cookies can be completely disabled in your browser at any time. VERRI uses technical cookies.

Profiling Cookies

Profiling cookies are designed to create user-related profiles and are used to send advertisements in line with the user preferences in the context of network browsing. Due to the particular invasiveness that such devices may have in the private sphere of users, European and Italian legislation provides that the user must be properly informed of their use and thus express his true consent. Art. 122 of the Privacy Code refers to profiling cookies where it provides that "the storage of information in a terminal of a contractor or a user or the access to information already archived is only permitted provided the contractor or the user has given his consent after having been informed with the simplified procedures referred to in Article 13, paragraph 3 "(Article 122, paragraph 1 of the Privacy Code). VERRI DOES NOT use these cookies.

Third party cookies

VERRI may also use cookies of different sites or web servers (so-called "third-party cookies"): this is because the site may include items such as images, maps, sounds, specific links to web pages from other domains resident on servers other than the one on which the requested page is located. In other words, these cookies are set directly by website managers or servers other than VERRI sites. These cookies are not controlled directly from VERRI site. To revoke your consent, you must refer to the relevant information on third-party websites. Specifically, most widely used third-party cookies are those that refer to the use of social plugins and the use of data collected through Google Analytics.

Cookie Duration

Some cookies (session cookies) remain active only until the browser closes or the logout command is executed. Other cookies "survive" at the closing of the browser and are still available on subsequent visits of the user. These cookies are called "persistent" and their duration is fixed by the server at the time of their creation. In some cases a deadline is set, in other cases the duration is unlimited. VERRI uses both persistent cookies and non-persistent cookies.

Manage cookies

You can also manage cookies through your browser settings. At any time you can accept, reject cookies, or decide to set a warning message before accepting a cookie from the websites you visit. The procedures for managing cookies differ depending on the browser you are using, by accessing the "Help" section, you can find out how to handle the settings. Please note that changing your settings will affect only that particular browser and PC. To align the behavior with other devices you must repeat the operation on each browser. We also remind you that by disabling some cookies, your website may not be able to provide you profiled services.
